



"Data-Driven Green Agriculture Transition: From Healthy Soils to Healthy People"

Abstract Submission Guidelines

The following guidelines outline the required format and submission procedures for abstracts and extended abstracts to be considered for inclusion in the conference proceedings.

1. Submission Requirements

Authors must prepare and submit the following documents:

1. Abstract – submitted as an individual MS Word file.
2. Extended Abstract – submitted as an individual MS Word file.

All submissions must be uploaded through the CMT (CMT link). Authors are required to create or maintain an active CMT account to complete the submission process.

The Extended Abstract must not exceed four (04) pages of text and must be formatted in a single-column layout.

To ensure an unbiased review process, author names, institutional affiliations, acknowledgements, and any other identifying information must not be included in either document.

2. Abstract Format Specifications

2.1 Title

- Maximum length: 100 characters (including spaces)
- Font: *Times New Roman*, 14 pt, bold

2.2 Abstract Body

- Maximum length: 250 words
- Citations and references are not permitted
- Font: *Times New Roman*, 12 pt
- Line spacing: 1.5

Note: Abstracts exceeding the word limit or containing citations will be returned for revision.

2.3 Keywords

- A maximum of five (05) keywords
- Font: *Times New Roman*, 11 pt, *italic*

Authors must strictly follow the formatting instructions provided in the official abstract template.

3. Extended Abstract Format Specifications

The Extended Abstract should be structured under the following headings:

1. Title
 - Font: *Times New Roman*, 14 pt, bold
2. Introduction
 - Font: *Times New Roman*, 12 pt, line spacing 1.5
3. Materials and Methods
 - Font: *Times New Roman*, 12 pt, line spacing 1.5
4. Results and Discussion
 - Font: *Times New Roman*, 12 pt, line spacing 1.5
5. Conclusions (where applicable)
 - Font: *Times New Roman*, 12 pt, line spacing 1.5
6. References
 - A maximum of eight (08) references
 - Font: *Times New Roman*, 12 pt, line spacing 1.5

All Extended Abstracts must adhere to the formatting requirements specified in the conference template.
